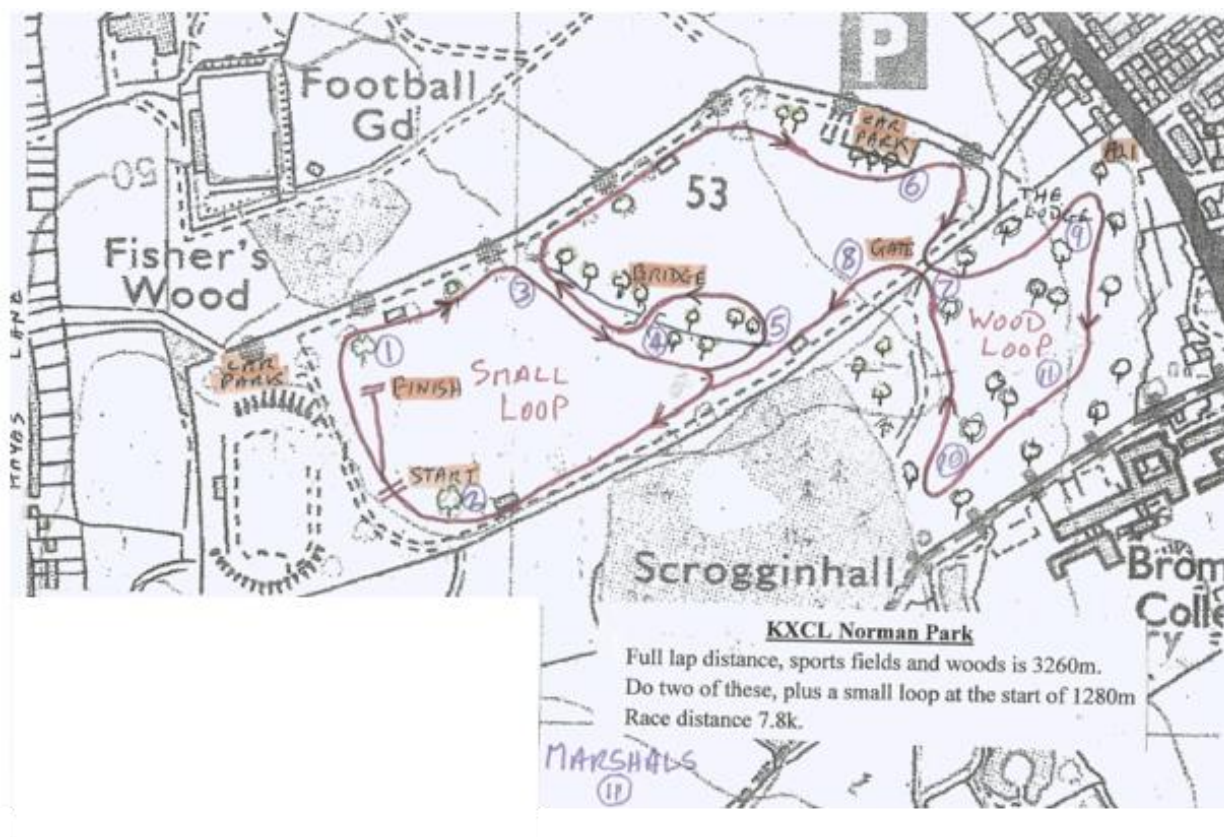

12 noon: Senior Women, 7.8km

1pm: Senior Men, 7.8km



Location and Parking

Norman Park is accessible from both Hayes Lane and Bromley Common, with free car parks at both ends of the park.

For Sat Nav use post code BR2 9EG for the Hayes Lane entrance or post code BR2 9SX for the Hook Farm Road (off Bromley Common, A21)

In addition, Bromley FC has kindly said that use of their car park (off Hayes Lane) is available this year for free, in the event that the public car parks are full.

Buses - the 61, 208, 261, 320, 358 all pass the Bromley Common A21 entrance to Norman Park. Alternatively, the 119, 146 and the 314 pass the Hayes Lane entrance to the park.

There is bike parking available at the Norman Park Community Sports Centre and by the bus stop in the car park (both Hayes Lane entrance)

Race HQ, Club Tents, Other Park Users

The Kent CAA tent (for pre-race queries and post-race presentations) will be located near the Start/Finish area.

Club tents, like last year, can be erected between the line of small trees and the path adjacent to the Start/Finish straight. Please don't restrict the public path or encroach onto the course. *Encroachment caused some problems last year so please be mindful.*

Please *do not warm up or cool down on the Football Pitches*

We do not have exclusive use of Norman Park for the XC races, so please be respectful to other users, walkers and dogs. Please take all your litter home

Toilets and Refreshments

There will be Portaloo's available in the park near the start/finish area. As with other Kent League fixtures there are no changing facilities for this event.

Trackside Café in the Norman Park Community Sports Centre is open until 4pm for hot and cold meals, drinks, and snacks. There are also toilets there but - please – DO NOT WEAR MUDDY SHOES (or wet socks!) in the Centre.
